**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF MEDDERS OIL COMPANY  
TO ESTABLISH AN MER FOR ITS FORKS CCC LEASE WELL NO. 1  
BALT (TANNEHILL) FIELD  
KING COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on July 7, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Medders Oil Company is granted such that its Forks CCC Lease Well No. 1 in the Balt (Tannehill) Field, King County, Texas, be and is hereby allowed to produce up to 180 barrels of oil per day.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Medders Oil Company Forks CCC Lease Well No. 1 in the Balt (Tannehill) Field, King County, be and is hereby canceled.
