FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF  
NEUMIN PRODUCTION COMPANY  
FOR MER ALLOWABLE  
FOR THE JACKS ET AL LEASE  
BIG JIM (THIRD SINTON) FIELD  
REFUGIO COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 3, 2002, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all wells on the Neumin Production Company Jacks et al Lease in the Big Jim (Third Sinton) Field, Refugio County, Texas, be and are hereby granted permission to produce under an MER allowable of 150 barrels of oil per day.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Neumin Production Company Jacks et al Lease Well No. 1 in the Big Jim (Third Sinton) Field, be and is hereby canceled as of the date of the Final Order.
