**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
HART PETROLEUM SERVICES, INC.
FOR AN MER ALLOWABLE
FOR ITS KEERAN LEASE WELL NO. 1
KOONTZ (5600) FIELD
VICTORIA COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on December 1, 2003, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Hart Petroleum Services, Inc., be and is hereby granted permission to produce its Keeran Lease Well No. 1, Koontz (5600) Field, Victoria County, Texas, under an MER allowable with a daily oil limit of 250 barrels.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Hart Petroleum Services, Inc., Keeran Lease Well No. 1, Koontz (5600) Field, be and is hereby canceled as of the date of the Final Order.
