**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF  
BURLINGTON RESOURCES O & G CO-PERMIAN  
FOR MER ALLOWABLES

WINKLER COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 5, 2002, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all wells in the Keystone, South (Devonian) Field, Winkler County, Texas, be and are hereby granted permission to produce under an MER allowable of 700 barrels of oil per day.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Burlington Resources O & G Co-Permian Keystone Cattle Company Lease Well No. 301 in the Keystone, South (Devonian) Field, be and is hereby canceled as of the date of the Final Order.
