**FINAL ORDER
MAKING PERMANENT THE MER AUTHORITY,
GRANTED IN OIL AND GAS DOCKET NO. 7B-0224824,
EFFECTIVE AUGUST 8, 2000,
FOR THE MULBERRY CANYON (CISCO) FIELD
NOLAN COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on July 17, 2001, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

It is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the MER of ONE HUNDRED (100) barrels of oil per day, with a net gas oil ratio of EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY (880) cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil produced, adopted in Oil & Gas Docket No. 7B-0224824, effective August 8th, 2000, for wells in the Mulberry Canyon (Cisco) Field, Nolan County, Texas, be made permanent.
