The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on July 19, 2002, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Great Western Drilling Company Brit Clare Lease Well No. 17 in the Prentice (Clear Fork, Lower) Field, be and is hereby canceled as of the date of the Final Order.
