## BRAC Membership

Yearly membership fees are required to use the Boys Ranch Activity Center. You must bring an ID and current utility bill showing Bedford residency to become a member at the resident rate. Ages 8 and under must always be accompanied by an adult 18 or older. There is a \$5 replacement fee for lost cards.

Members of the BRAC 16 years old and older have the option of purchasing a weight room and cardio room membership (14-15 years old must be accompanied by an adult). The BRAC fitness room houses cardio equipment, universal machine weights and dumbbells. You must have a BRAC membership card to purchase fitness room memberships. 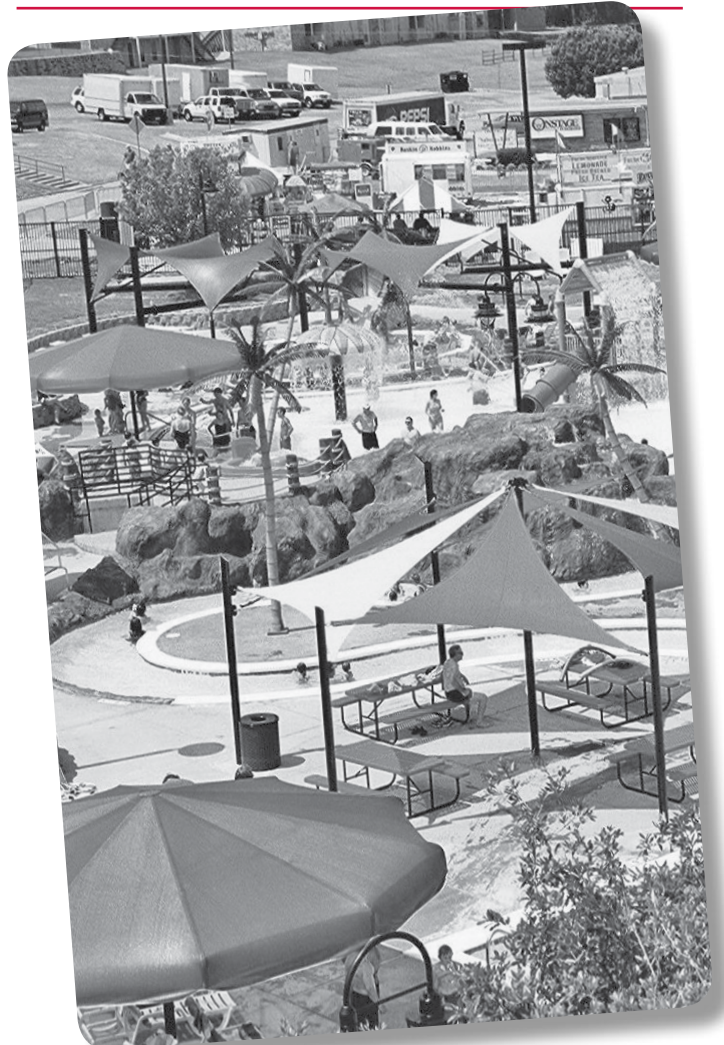

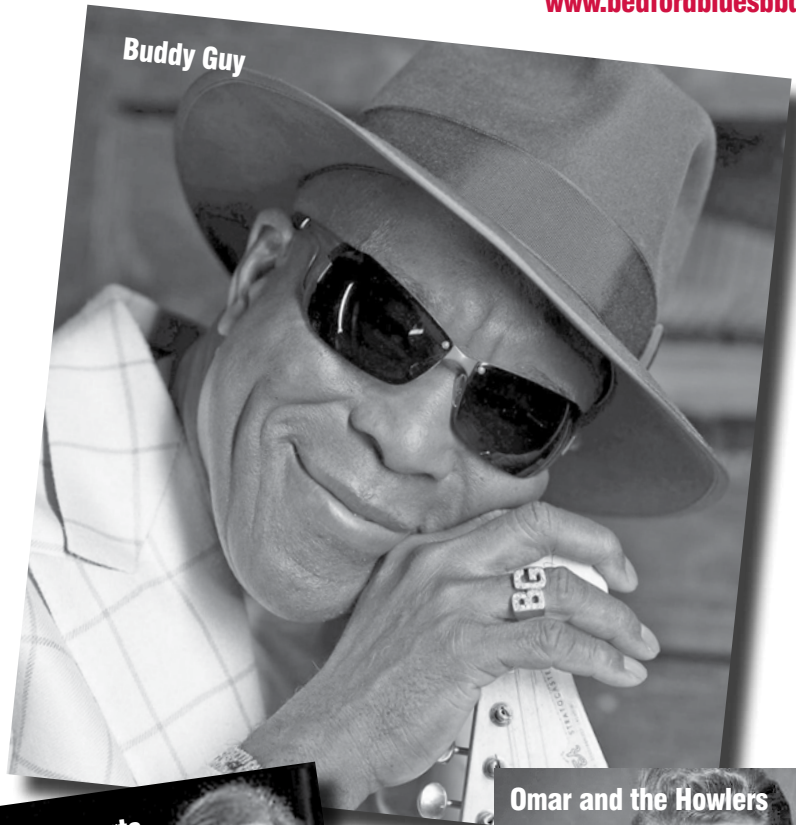

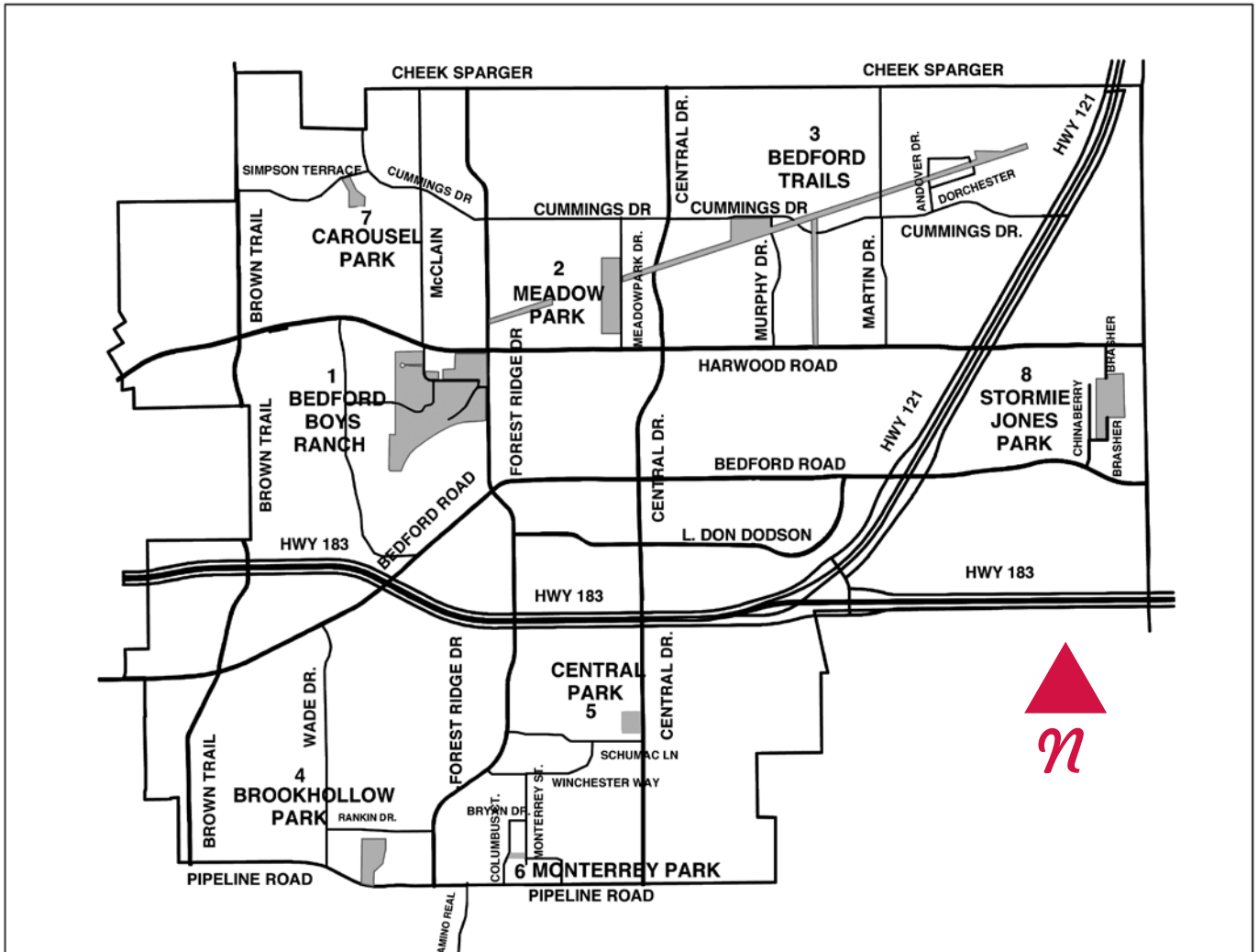

# City Parks

## 1. Boys Ranch Park & Activity Center • 2801 Forest Ridge Dr.

This 68 acre park has plenty of open spaces and an urban lake with a .4 mile jogging path. The Boys Ranch Activity Center (BRAC) has a gym, fitness room, showers and lockers, and classrooms. Other features of our largest park are: 3 youth baseball fields, outdoor roller hockey court, play structures, large corporate pavilion, 3 soccer fields, 2 sand volleyball courts, Aquatic Center and 2 small pavilions.



## 2. Meadowpark Athletic Complex • 3200 Meadowpark

There are 2 lighted softball fields, a youth soccer field, a concession stand and a play structure in addition to the City's tree farm at this 11 acre park.



## 3. Bedford Trails/Linear Park

This 32-acre linear park which follows the T.X.U. easement in northeast Bedford has 1.5 miles of dual trails, a playground, security lighting and a pavilion.



## 4. Brook Hollow Park • 600 Block of Rankin

This 9-acre park in southwest Bedford has a playground, small basketball court, practice soccer field and picnic area.



## 5. Central Park • 1200 Central Drive

This 5-acre park contains play structures, sand volleyball court and pavilion.



## 6. Monterrey Park • 1000 Block of Monterrey

This small 1/2-acre residential park in south Bedford, located just north of Pipeline Rd., has a small play structure, picnic areas and plenty of shade.



## 7. Carousel Park • 1100 Simpson Terrace

There are plenty of shade trees and several play structures in this 1-acre community park.



## 8. Stormie Jones Park • 2500 Block of Brasher

This secluded 13-acre community park features two "premier" lighted soccer fields, a .5 mile walking/jogging trail, an exercise unit, picnic areas, a small pavilion, a sand volleyball court, restrooms and plenty of trees.
