Park Rules

A complete list of rules and regulations is available at the front office. These are also posted throughout the park.

- Public consumption or display of alcohol is prohibited.
- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. - 6 a.m.
- Loud music is not permitted at any time.
- Pets must be kept on a leash at all times and are not permitted in the lake.
- Gathering of firewood is prohibited.
- Absolutely do not feed or annoy the alligators or any other wildlife.

Day Use

An entrance fee of \$4 per person per day is charged for anyone 13 years and older, unless a visitor has obtained a Texas State Parks Pass or a Parklands Passport. (This fee is also added to camping fees.)

Group Facilities

Group Screened Shelter - DAY USE ONLY.

\$40/1,200 sq. ft. Lights/electrical outlets, ceiling fans, serving counter, picnic tables. Day use fee per person still applies.

Group Recreational Hall - DAY USE ONLY.

\$250 per day plus \$1 entrance fee per person for anyone 13 years and older. 4,000+ sq. ft. Capacity of 200 people. Central heating and A/C. Kitchen area has a refrigerator, electric range and serving bar and counter. Separate men's and women's rest rooms inside.

Camping

All campsites are limited to eight people and two vehicles. Sites are first come, first serve. You cannot reserve a specific site. You can reserve a specific camping area.



Coloneh Camping Area - \$12 per night per campsite. Campsite includes picnic table and fire ring, water faucet for each two sites, three rest rooms in area with hot and cold showers, lighted fishing pier, fish cleaning facility. (96 sites)

Raven Hill Trailer Area - \$16 per night per campsite. Pull-through campsites include electricity; water, picnic table and fire ring. rest rooms nearby with hot and cold showers. (25 sites)

Prairie Branch Camping Area - \$16 per night per campsite. Back-in campsites include water, electricity, picnic table and a fire ring. Lighted fishing pier and fish cleaning facility, rest rooms with hot and cold showers, playground. (36 sites)

Screened Shelters - \$20 per night per shelter.

12' x 18' building with a concrete floor, picnic table inside, electrical outlet, water faucet and a cooking grill. (30 shelters) RECREATIONAL VEHICLES CANNOT DRAW ELECTRICITY FROM THE SHELTERS.

Boat Rentals

- \$25 for three hours
- \$30 for all day
- \$10 deposit required for all rentals
- \$45 for overnight credit card required + \$50 deposit
