



Choke Canyon

For people who love boating, waterskiing and swimming, Choke Canyon State Park is the place to go. Two units, Calliham and South Shore (day use only), lie on the shores of Choke Canyon Lake, a massive 26,000-acre reservoir. In addition to water activities, the park also offers excellent birding and other wildlife watching.



Group Facilities: Group picnic pavilion (capacity 50). Sponsored youth group area: recreation hall with kitchen; gymnasium with dining hall.


Picnicking: Picnic sites with fire rings.

Swimming: In Choke Canyon Reservoir.

Boating: Boat ramp.

Fishing: Largemouth bass, white bass, bluegill, white crappie, striped bass and channel catfish. A stocked 75-acre lake provides fishing (Calliham Unit).

Special Features: Calliham Unit has tennis and basketball courts, a baseball diamond, and an auditorium with kitchen.
