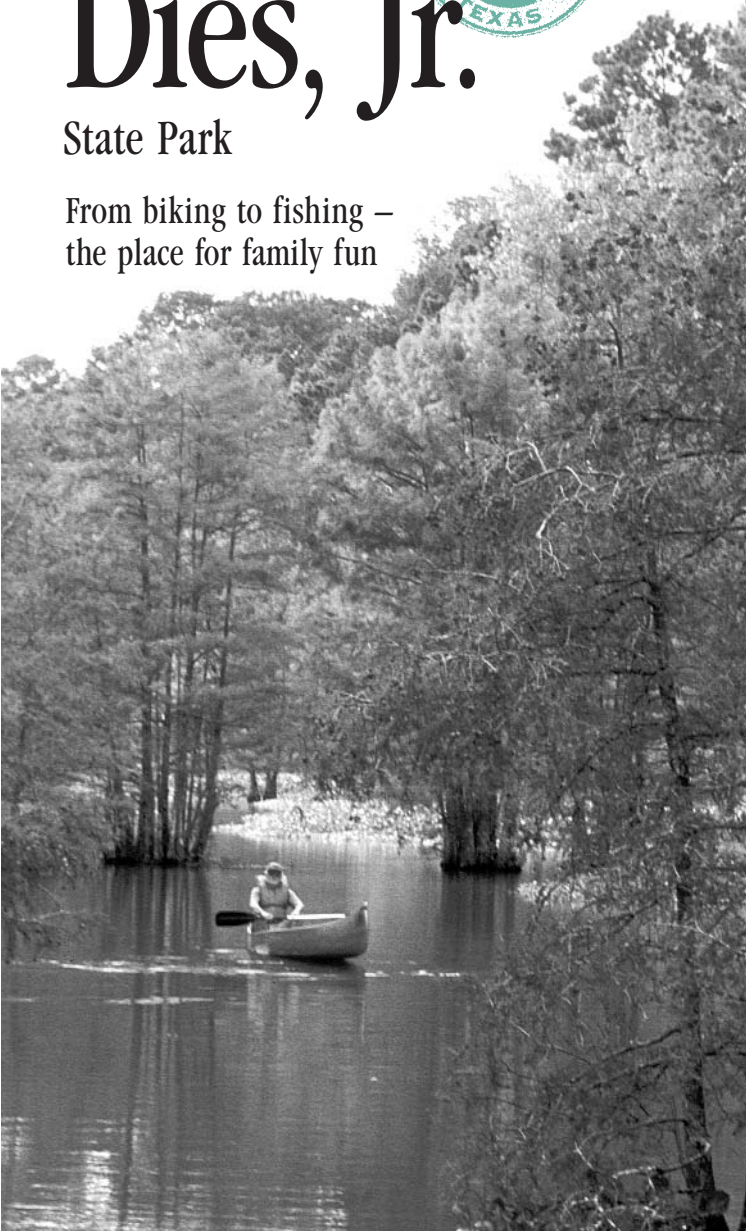

Martin Dies, Jr. State Park

Bring the tricycle as well as the fishing rods because Martin Dies, Jr. State Park is the perfect place for family fun. Situated on the shores of B.A. Steinhagen Reservoir, the park offers a number of recreational opportunities, including picnicking, fishing, swimming, canoeing, boating, biking and hiking. In the spring, wild azaleas and dogwoods burst into bloom, and blooming magnolias are followed in the fall by the colorful leaves of blackgum, oak and beech trees. The park lies at the gateway to the Big Thicket and several wildlife management areas.



Camping: campsites with water only or water and electricity. Weekly and monthly rates. Screened shelters. Limited use cabins with HVAC.



Group Facilities: dining hall w/kitchen (capacity 150).



Picnicking: picnic tables and grills in day use area.



Swimming: permitted in reservoir.



Fishing: lighted fishing piers. Possible catches include bass, crappie and catfish.



Boating: boat ramps. Also canoeing in lake.



Concessions: bike, boat and canoe rentals. Horseshoes and volleyball equipment rentals.



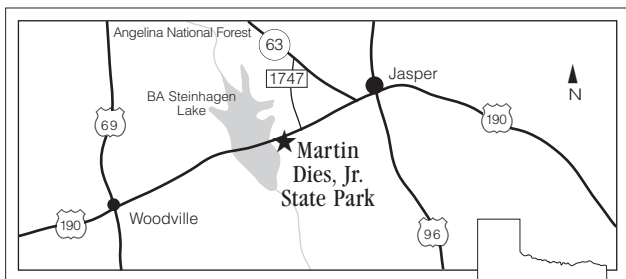
Nature Center: scheduled resource education programs; also by request: gifts, books and more.



Trails: hiking and nature trails.



Special Feature: wildscape/herb garden.



Located in Tyler and Jasper counties; 12 miles west from Jasper on U.S. 190 to Park Road 48, or 15 miles east from Woodville on U.S. 190 to Park Road 48.
