Fanthorp Inn State Historic Site

In the early days of the Texas Republic, Fanthorp Inn was just a small log house shared by its owners with passing travelers. As the number of paying guests increased, Henry and Rachel Fanthorp steadily enlarged the building, which became known for its food and hospitality. Several famous people, such as Sam Houston and Anson Jones, stayed at the inn. Today Fanthorp Inn State Historic Site preserves the two-story hotel, which has been meticulously restored to its 1850 appearance.


Picnicking: picnic sites with tables.
