Participants will drive their own vehicles in a caravan behind their guide for approximately seven miles from park headquarters to the Gorman area of the park and then hike to the base of the falls. From the trailhead, it is a one and one-half-mile, round-trip hike that is moderate until the last 40-50 yards. At this point, the trail becomes more difficult over the rocky, descend-

WILD CAVE Discover what speleologists (cavers) experience while exploring the underground world. The self-guided crawling exploration lets you venture out without a guide for a true caving experience. Map and information are provided to launch your exploration of the many tunnels and passageways provided by our crawling cave. If you are looking for something different to do, this is it! The walking cave tour takes you to the larger Gorman cave on a guided interpretive tour that includes a picturesque three-mile round-trip hike. All cave tours are resource and weather permitting.

WALKING CAVE TOUR	 9:15 a.m. SATURDAYS and SUNDAYS. Tour lasts approximately three hours. \$15 per person Hardhat (provided) is required. Flashlight is required. Bring your own. Maximum of 10 people allowed on tour.
SELF-GUIDED CRAWLING CAVE EXPLORATION	 9 a.m3 p.m. (only on the FIRST SATURDAY of each month) \$30 per person Long sleeves and gloves are highly recommended in addition to long pants. Knee and elbow pads are strongly recommended. Three sources of light are required. Minimum of three people and maximum of ten allowed on tour.
INFORMATION	 Reservations are highly recommended as tour size is limited. Reservations must be pre-paid. Call the park at (325) 628-3240 for reservations. No children under the age of six allowed on cave tours. No rest rooms or drinking water provided on tours. Pets are not allowed on tour or left unattended. Wear old clothes and substantial footwear. Long pants are recommended.
