MISSION

Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) is primarily a Research and Development Center for several tenant organizations under the Air Force Material Command.

TENANT UNITS

KAFB is the home of the 377th Air Base Wing, the host tenant, and the 542nd Crew Training Wing. Kirtland's population is approximately 18,000. It is the location for the Air Force Inspection and Safety Agencies, the Theater Command and Control Simulation Facility and proposed location for the consolidation of Phillips Lab. A few of the major tenant organizations are: Air Force Weapons Laboratory, Naval Weapons Laboratory, Sandia National Laboratories, Department of Energy, AFLIC Nuclear Support Agency, Defense Nuclear Agency, Air Force Research Labs, Air Force Test and Evaluation Center, 58th Special Operations Wing, and the New Mexico Air National Guard.

As a result of BRAC 05, the installation is expected to gain the Space Vehicles Battlespace mission, currently located at Hanscom AFB.
