Each person must also file the statement of officer with the local authority prior to assuming the duties of office. If a bond is required for such office, the bond is filed with the oath. Section 604.001, Government Code.

Persons elected to regular terms of office take office on the first day of January following their election, or as soon thereafter as possible. Section 601.003, Texas Government Code.

The County Clerk certifies the names and dates of qualification of county and precinct officers to the Secretary of State for issuance of commissions. Section 601.006, Texas Government Code.
