NOTICE TO VOTER

You may vote at this polling location only if:

1. You are at least 18 years old on Election Day;
2. You are registered to vote in the precinct in which you are attempting to vote and you are a resident of the territory covered by the election;
3. You are a United States citizen;
4. You are not a convicted felon (you may be eligible to vote if you have completed your sentence, probation, and parole); and
5. You have not been declared by a court of law to be either totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote.
 - It is a third degree felony to vote illegally or knowingly impersonate another person or to vote as the impersonated person and it is a Class A misdemeanor to attempt any of these activities. Tex. Elec. Code Ann. § 64.012.

3. *Es un ciudadano de los Estados Unidos;*
4. *No es un criminal condenado (puede ser elegible para votar si ha terminado su sentencia y libertad condicional); y*
5. *No ha sido declarado por un tribunal de justicia ser totalmente o parcialmente incapacitado de mente sin derecho a votar.*
 - *Votar ilegalmente o hacerse pasar por otra persona cuando vote es un delito de tercer grado y es un delito menor intentar hacer alguno de estas actividades. Tex. Elec. Code Ann. § 64.012.*
