## **Comments:**

If the ballots will be corrected by use of stickers or pasters or by darkening out obscure language, the notice is not required to be filed with the Secretary of State.

Failure to deliver this notice within the time period is a Class A misdemeanor.

If the authority responsible determines to print new ballots, the new ballots must be numbered beginning with number 1 and numbered consecutively.
