Comments:

The roster shall be preserved for the period for preserving the precinct election records.

Information on the roster for a person who votes an early voting ballot by mail shall be made available for public inspection not later than the day following the day the early voting clerk receives a ballot voted by mail.

It is recommended that a separate list be maintained for voters whose ballots have been returned to accommodate easier responses to public information requests.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR EARLY VOTING BY MAIL

1. Under the column of “precinct number,” record the voter’s county election precinct number.
2. Under the column for “date,” record the date the ballot was mailed.
3. **FPCA Registrant**
If the applicant is applying for a ballot on an FPCA application, check “FPCA” under the notation column.
4. The names of voters are put on the Roster for Early Voting by Mail 24 hours after the ballot has been mailed to the voter.
