Purpose:

To provide voter proof that application was canceled so he/she can vote regular ballot on election day at polling place.

Number of Copies Required:

Early Voting Clerk.

Filed with:

Original to voter, copy attached to request to cancel and the application for a mail ballot.

Comments:

If the voter's name has not been added to the precinct list of early voters, the early voting clerk does not need to provide the voter with this proof. If the name has been added to the precinct list of early voters and the election judge at the polling place has already received the list so the clerk cannot remove the name from the list, the early voting clerk must provide the voter with this notice.

This is not necessary for the procedures where (1) the voter cancels at the polling place by turning in the ballot or (2) use the appropriate oath on the provisional voting form if the voter does not have the ballot to turn in.
