INSTRUCTIONS

The early voting clerk completes the first half of the form prior to delivering the early voting materials to the early voting ballot board judge. The judge completes the remainder of the form after the ballots have been qualified. The form is returned to the custodian of election records with other early voting records.

Line 4 + line 6 = line 2.

Line 3 – line 6 = line 5. If ballots are counted automatically at the central counting station, the number of ballots recorded on the ballot and seal certificate is the same as line 5.
