# Secondary Level and All Level Teacher Certification Information

### **Teacher Education Admission Requirements:**

- 1. Junior standing (minimum of 60 earned hours)
- 2. A 2.75 overall GPA and a 2.75 UNT GPA
- 3. Appropriate THEA scores

(required for ALL persons seeking teacher certification)

- a. minimum 240 reading, 230 math, 220 writing
- b. only allowable exemptions: SAT, ACT, TAKS/TAAS
- c. For THEA testing information:

- 4. An official degree plan with certification
- 5. A signed Application for Admission to Teacher Education

### **Application for Admission to Teacher Education:**

- Applications submitted without an appointment are processed within 7-10 business days.
- You must submit an official degree plan that includes teacher certification courses at time of application.

#### **State Certification Exams**

All certification students must pass state certification exams to become teacher certified in the state of Texas:

- **#1 Pedagogy and Professional Responsibilities (PPR)** 8-12 or EC-12. This test will cover your knowledge of good teaching practices and the ways in which a professional teacher should behave in school settings.
- **#2 Content area** The test will cover your knowledge of the subject(s) that you will be teaching as a professional teacher in a school setting.
- **#3 Texas Oral Proficiency Test (TOPT)** required only for Spanish and French content areas. This will test your fluency\*.
