CRITERIA FOR FACULTY/ STAFF/RETIREES/DEPENDANTS PRESIDENT'S EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

FACULTY /STAFF/RETIREE CRITERIA:

- 1. Applications must be submitted each year for enrollment to be considered for eligibility.
- 2. The individual must be:
 - a. A full-time nine or twelve month faculty or staff member who is employed on a 100% basis and who is enrolled in either TRS or ORP or
 - b. A part-time (50-99%) regular faculty or staff member who has been employed for a minimum of five years in at least a part-time regular, benefits eligible employment at UNT or UNT HSC (years do not have to be continuous) or
 - c. A retiree of UNT or UNT HSC under TRS or ORP programs.
- 3. Faculty and staff members who are new or former entering students and who meet applicable requirements for admission in good standing to the UNT HSC are eligible. Faculty or staff members who are continuing students must be in good standing with the UNT HSC.
- 4. The faculty or staff member must not have any outstanding debt (returned checks, tuition, student loans and applicable fees) with the UNT HSC at the time the Scholarship Application is processed, and the award is applied to the student's account.
- 5. Except as stated in item #4 above, an individual must be eligible under these criteria as of the 12^{th} class day of the respective long session or the 4^{th} class day of the summer term.

DEPENDANT CRITERIA:

- 1. The spouse/parent/guardian of the dependant must meet the criteria stated in 1, 2, 4 and 5 above.
- 2. The individual must meet the following definition of a "dependant":
 - A dependant is a spouse (as defined in the Texas Family Code) of an employee and/or unmarried child under 25 years of age including: the natural child of an employee; a legally adopted child; a stepchild; foster child; or any other child, regardless of age, who lives with or whose care is provided by an employee on a regular basis, if the child is physically or mentally disabled to such an extent as to be dependent on the employee for care and support.
- 3. Dependants who are new or former entering students and who meet applicable requirements for admission in good standing to the UNT HSC are eligible. Faculty or staff members are continuing students must be in good standing with the UNT HSC to be eligible.
- 4. A dependant must be eligible under these criteria as of the 12^{th} class day of the respective long session or the 4^{th} class day of the summer term.
