## **Culminating Experience: MPH Comprehensive Examination**

### **Administrative Details for Students**

The following information is meant to inform students who intend to take the Comprehensive Examination as their culminating experience within their MPH degree plan.

#### Requirements:

- A student may qualify to sit for the examination after they have completed <u>ALL</u> core courses and <u>ALL</u> required coursework for the MPH degree in Community Health.
  - Note: A student can sit for the examination while taking the final semester credit hours (SCH) of the required coursework after approval from their Advisor.
- A student should notify their Academic Advisor before the week of final examinations of the semester preceding the one in which they want to take the comprehensive exam.
- Upon approval of their Academic Advisor, the student shall complete a Comprehensive Examination Registration Form and submit it to the Social & Behavioral Sciences Administrative Office – EAD 713 – prior to the end of the preceding semester.

#### Additional Examination details:

- The exam will be administered on the UNTHSC campus in a secure and restricted access environment, proctored by a faculty member.
- The total time allowed for completion of the exam is four hours.
- ➤ No outside resources, e.g., books, notes, will be allowed.
- ➤ No electronic devices of any kind including those with internet connectivity will be allowed.
- ➤ No cell phones, iPods, blackberries, PDA's, or pagers will be allowed.
- The examination will be graded as Pass/Fail by a committee of faculty members, and communicated to the student within two weeks.
- A student who fails the exam may retake the exam the following semester.
- A student who does not retake the exam or fails for the second time will be withdrawn from the program.
