Users of the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board Manual of Procedure (TBMP) must note that the latest revision of the manual occurred in March 2004 and, therefore, some of its information is out of date.

Revising and Updating of the TBMP:

Because of the format in which the TBMP was posted on the web, it could not be easily updated, in a section-by-section or chapter-by-chapter manner. The Board now has more than a dozen Administrative Trademark Judges and Interlocutory Attorneys working on a revision of the entire manual. When complete, the revised TBMP will reflect current rules of practice and cite to many precedential decisions issued during recent years. The revised manual will be posted on the web in both PDF and HTML formats and will be both more easily searched by users and more easily updated by the Board. The revision project began in mid-2009 and is expected to be completed in 2010.
