On June 11, 2009, Secretary Hilda Solis announced the awarding of 75 YouthBuild grants, to 96 entities located in 43 states and the District of Columbia totaling approximately \$47 million.	The Employment and Training Administration (ETA) is currently reviewing applications from Michigan, Montana, and Wisconsin for their initial 1/3 shares; from Nevada for its remaining 2/3rds share; and from Kansas for its 100 percent share of Unemployment Insurance (UI) Modernization incentive payments.
As a result of the Recovery Act provision that provides for temporary 100 percent Federal funding of the costs of the permanent federal-state extended benefits program, 16 states have amended their state laws to add Total Unemployment Rate triggers. An additional two states, Tennessee and Missouri, have legislation awaiting their Governors' signatures. All of these enactments are temporary, with most expiring as soon as the 100 percent Federal funding for all claims expires at the end of 2009.	A release is expected shortly to announce a National Emergency Grant (NEG) for workers at ACE Precision and Lennox Precision Castings in Iowa. The Iowa Workforce Development submitted a dual enrollment application for \$469,694 to serve approximately 60 of the 370 workers affected by the closure of ACE Precision Castings, LLC (10) and layoffs from Lennox Industries, Inc. (50). We will be recommending that the application be approved for \$469,694, and be funded by resources made available for NEGs under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009.
