

Trinity River Restoration Program

Project Description

The channel rehabilitation aspect of the Trinity River Restoration Program (TRRP) involves restoring and maintaining the river channel at 44 locations along the Trinity River. Four locations will be rehabilitated in 2010 including Lowden Ranch, Trinity House Gulch, Upper Reading Creek, and Lower Reading Creek. American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 funding will assist with restoration activities including: floodplain lowering/re-contouring, side channel development, gravel augmentation, large woody debris placement, riparian establishment and other habitat enhancement activities.

Project Benefits

- Accelerate the completion of the channel rehabilitation aspect of the program.
- Provide a more efficient construction schedule.
- Provide important aquatic habitat in support of the Trinity Basin tribal, sporting and commercial fishery.
