GivingSphere asks whether it may transmit its customers' rebates to political committees; may provide its customers with a searchable database of political committees; may provide its customers with additional information on political committees; may sell advertising space to political committees on its website; may permit political committees to post a GivingSphere "badge" on their websites; and must file reports with the Commission.
