LANDFIRE Website Library

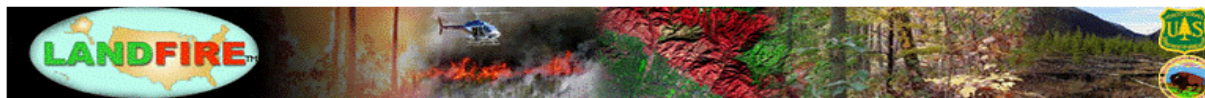
