Golden Gate Bridge  
November 14-17, 2011**

The Department's Office of Law Enforcement and Security in coordination with the National Park Service and the United States Park Police will be hosting a Security and Intelligence Workshop from November 14-17, 2011 at the Cavallo Point Lodge, San Francisco, CA. The Workshop format is designed to provide Department of the Interior (DOI) personnel with a collaborative forum to examine current Departmental and Governmental security and intelligence policies, procedures and best practices. Workshop topics will include: employee security awareness training; security and intelligence programs and policy updates; major event planning; insider threats; domestic threats; emergency management issues; etc. The highlight of the workshop will be a tour of the physical security program at the Golden Gate Bridge and the Northern California Regional Intelligence Center/FBI Joint Terrorism Task Force.

**Workshop Theme:** DOI's role in protecting the Nation's Critical Infrastructure and Key Resources. The Golden Gate Bridge is an example of DOI's efforts to support the security programs of non-Department owned critical infrastructure. The Golden Gate Bridge is located on and surrounded by National Park Service lands. The National Park Service and the United States Park Police play an integral part in the bridge's security plan.

**Target Audience:** Workshop subject matter is directed toward DOI security, intelligence, personnel security, human resource, law enforcement and all associated personnel with responsibility or interest in bureau/office security and intelligence programs.

**Method of Delivery:** Presentations and Demonstrations focused on the training needs of security, intelligence, and law enforcement professionals.

**Training Requirements:** The Workshop may be used by law enforcement and security personnel to meet 28 hours of the mandated annual in-service training requirement.

**Dates and Location:** November 14, 2011 – November 17, 2011 at the Cavallo Point Lodge, 601 Murray Circle, Sausalito, CA 94965
