#### The CDMRP...

- Finds and funds the best research to eradicate diseases and support the warfighter for the benefit of the American public.
- Includes consumer advocates who are either survivors, family members, or caregivers throughout its processes.
- Conducts two levels of review to determine the best and most relevant research through open competition.
- Funds research at for-profit, non-profit, public, and private organizations, such as universities, colleges, hospitals, laboratories, companies, and government agencies.
- Receives congressional appropriations for targeted research in specific diseases, conditions, and injuries.
- Creates innovative funding opportunities to address issues that will move research in prevention, diagnosis, and treatment forward to improve health for the military and the public.

# When Can I Apply?

You can apply after the release of a Program Announcement that provides the description and submission requirements for that funding opportunity. A brief overview of the application process follows. Please note: This information should not be construed as the official requirements for any specific application submission.

# Can Companies and Organizations Apply?

Your organization must be registered with Grants.gov, which requires a DUNS number, a current CCR (Central Contractor Registration) number, and an Authorized Organization Representative or Business Official to submit applications through Grants.gov.

# When Will I Know if My Application Will Be Funded?

The cover of each Program Announcement indicates the month of the Programmatic Review during which funding recommendations are made. Applicants are notified of their funding status (either selected or not selected for funding) in writing 6–8 weeks after this review.

# Why Does the Military Fund Medical Research?

The CDMRP arose from a unique partnership among the U.S. Congress, the public, and the U.S. military. Success in managing the initial congressional appropriation in breast cancer, combined with the need for focused biomedical research, positioned the CDMRP into a principal funding organization for cancer research, military-relevant medical research, and other disease-specific research.

- 2. Select Synopsis of Current Program Announcements from the Funding Opportunities menu.
- Scroll down and select a program from the Synopsis of Current Program Announcements. View the links to a specific Program Announcement and General Application Instructions. Information regarding funding amount(s) and submission deadlines is also listed.
- Read the Program Announcement for intent, details on pre-application and application submission requirements, and review criteria.
- Review the General Application Instructions for further details on pre-application submission to <a href="https://cdmrp.org">https://cdmrp.org</a>, and application submission to Grants.gov as well as U.S. Army regulatory requirements.

- Check with your business office to identify your Organization Representative or Business Official and his/her deadlines or schedules.
- 7. Complete the required pre-application on the CDMRP eReceipt system at <a href="https://cdmrp.org">https://cdmrp.org</a> at least 48 hours ahead of the deadline. Please note: DRAFT submissions will not be accepted. The deadline for pre-application submission is set at 5:00 p.m. United States Eastern Time on the deadline date.
- Using the Grants.gov application package for your specific Program Announcement, prepare your portion of the application with your registered Organization Representative who is responsible for submitting your application through <a href="http://grants.gov">http://grants.gov</a>.
- Complete the application package at least 48–72 hours prior to the deadline. Grants.gov will notify you of errors and allow you to resubmit until the official deadline. The deadline for application submission is 11:59 p.m. United States Eastern Time on the deadline date.
