Duties and Responsibilities: **HIGHLY DESIRED: Experience managing and coordinating SIGINT operations in an Air Force SIGINT squadron. DESIRED: Experience with SIGINT operations within the Air Force Distributed Common Ground System.** Serves as SIGINT SME to CONR-1AF (AFNORTH)/A2, CONR-1AF (AFNORTH) senior leadership, NORTHCOM, HAF, MAJCOMs. Responsible for coordination of AF SIGINT operations to support CONR-1AF (AFNORTH)/CC and staff to plan and conduct military operations in the NORTHCOM AOR. As required, assists planning, development and execution of ISR related Theater Security Cooperation activities and SMEs with regional partners across the DoD. Responsible for SIGINT operations support to the component NAF to include operation and exercise planning and SIGINT programming planning support. Identifies and assesses future SIGINT requirements to include potential training and implementation of new and emerging technologies. As directed, represents CONR-1AF (AFNORTH) ISR operations at National Intelligence Community, DoD, HAF, MAJCOM, and COCOM planning workshops, conferences, and other forums; advises all levels of the AF and DoD on AF/AFNORTH SIGINT capabilities for incorporation into mission plans and activities; Provides SIGINT operations-related briefings, papers, and other information as required. As directed, fills A2 position in the AFNORTH CAT during real-world or exercise situations

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.
