



PAPERWORK REDUCTION ACT NOTICE: The Paperwork Reduction Act says we must tell you why we are collecting this information, how we will use it, and whether you have to give it to us. We ask for the information to carry out the U.S. Customs and Border Protection laws. We need it when an agent of the consignee has knowledge of the facts and is authorized by that consignee to execute the declarations on the entry or entry summary, in compliance with Section 484 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended. Your response is required to obtain a benefit.
