The LCPII is an outstanding program to enhance leadership effectiveness through self-awareness using leading psychometrics that focus on multiple leadership challenges. This dynamic group will not only get their 360 degree feedback via MBTI, Campbell's Leadership Index, and other tools, but they will network with other SMSgt's that will become our next group of Chiefs to lead the ANG and AF. Chief Muncy is planning to drop in and let this dynamic group of leaders discuss their views, concerns, and needs for the way ahead. There is a maximum class size of 30 students.

Course material is funded by NGB, however, travel/per diem, days are UNIT FUNDED. Lodging is on base at McGhee-Tyson.
