General Financial Aid Facts

- The University processes over 30 million dollars in financial aid annually
- The only form you are required to file is the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) annually
- File this application *after January 1* of your senior year in high school, but make sure you file your FAFSA *by March 1!*

Filing for Aid & Scholarships

- File electronically at www.fafsa.ed.gov
- List all of the schools you are interested in attending on the FAFSA (IUSB is **001816**).
- The application deadline IU South Bend scholarships is **March 1**.
