This reprogramming transfers \$62.0 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 12/13, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 12/12, appropriation consistent with the provisions in Title IX Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO) of Division A of Public Law 112-74, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2012, for OCO related drug interdiction and counter-drug activities.

Realignment of funds between counter-drug projects may be accomplished only with prior approval of the Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Counternarcotics and Global Threats in the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense (Policy).
