Provenance

Official records of William Jefferson Clinton's presidency are housed at the Clinton Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2006-0482-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA request 2006-0482-F consists of correspondence between President Clinton and Henry Diamond. The correspondence centers around a letter sent to President Clinton from four members of the American Conservation Association, including Henry Diamond, regarding the condition of the national parks. President Clinton's response to the American Conservation Association is included. In addition, internal White House emails discuss the processing of the Presidential response.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area - Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files. WHORM Subject files are processed at the document level.

The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. A complete listing of the categories with detailed descriptions is provided in our research room.
