Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 USC 2201) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 USC 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (17 USC 101), which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

Provenance

Official records of William Jefferson Clinton's presidency are housed at the Clinton Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2006-0550-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA request 2006-0550-F contains material pertaining to correspondence between President Clinton and Stephen Hawking.

The WHORM Subject Files contain six subject file categories. These categories contain correspondence in the form of letters and draft letters between President Clinton and Stephen Hawking relating to the White House Millennium Lectures. Included in the correspondence is a letter from President Clinton to Stephen Hawking with an excerpt of the remarks made by President Clinton at the University of Warwick on December 14, 2000. The background material consist of biographical information on Stephen Hawking and a copy of the lecture delivered by Stephen Hawking for the White House Millennium Lectures.

The White House Staff and Office Files contain one file relating to correspondence between President Clinton and Stephen Hawking. The records contain letters and draft letters which includes thank you letters relating to e-mails and the Millenium Lecture.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in two collection areas – Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files, Clinton Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area. WHORM Subject and WHORM Alpha files are processed at the document level.

The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designed by a letter/number combination. A complete listing of the categories with detailed descriptions is provided in our research room.
