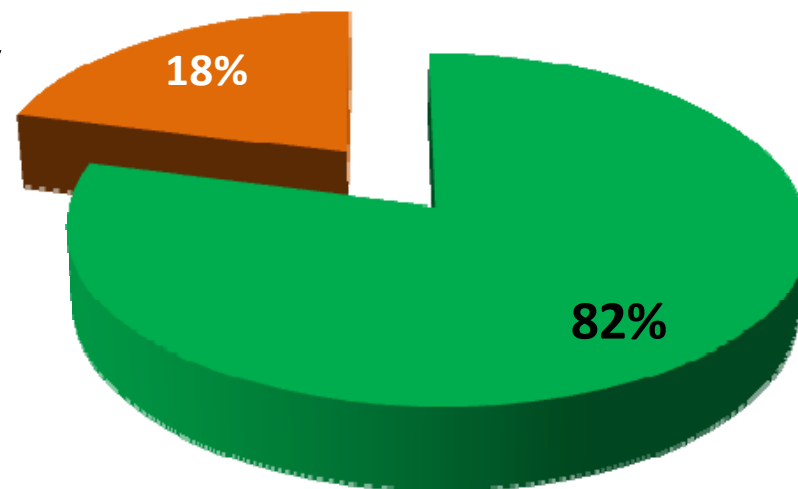

Testing and diagnosis is prevention and care

- 18% (207,000) with undiagnosed HIV
Associated with ~50% of sexual transmission
- 82% (941,000) diagnosed
More likely to access prevention and treatment



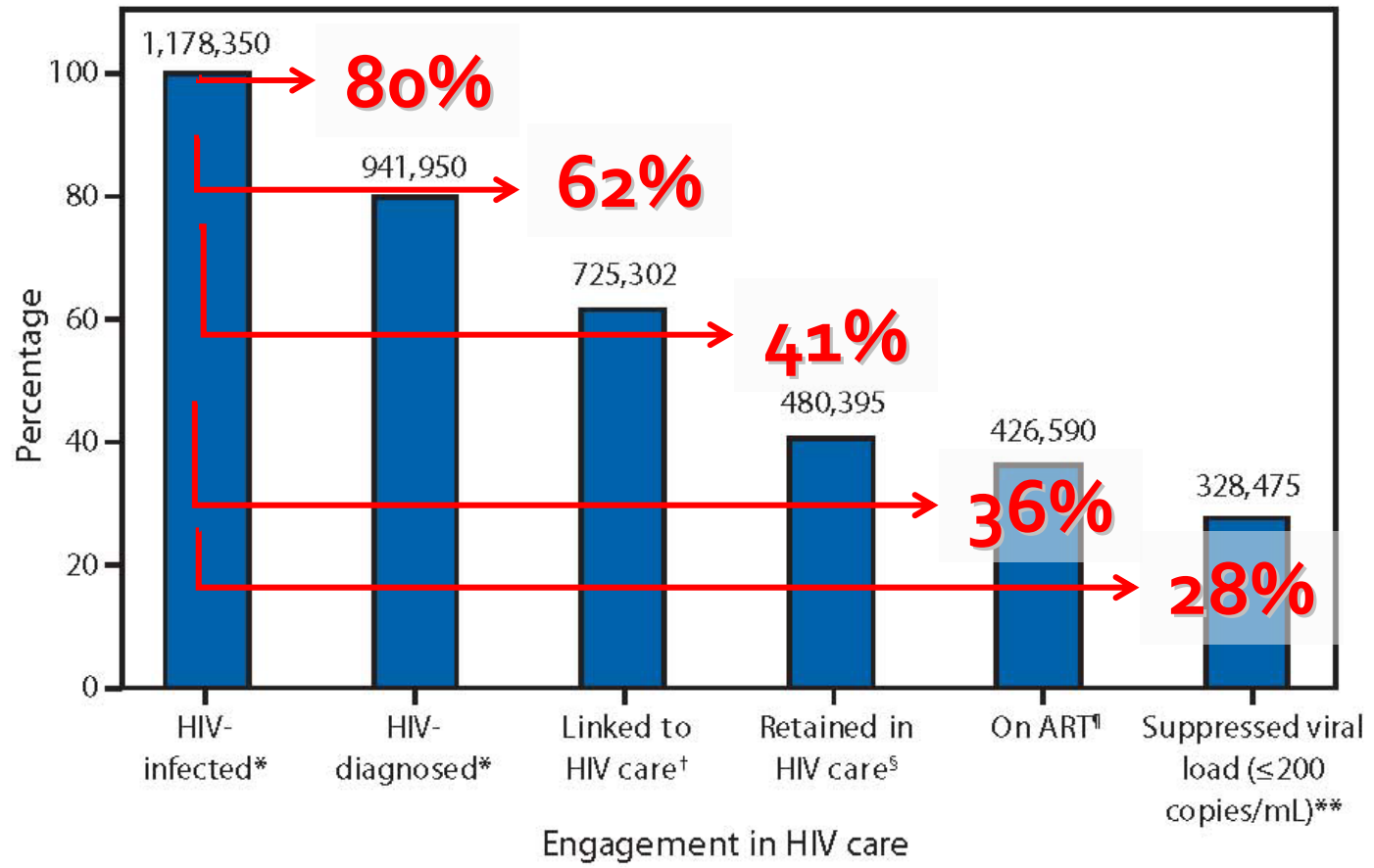
National HIV/AIDS Strategy goal is 90% of people with HIV diagnosed by 2015

Late HIV Testing is Common

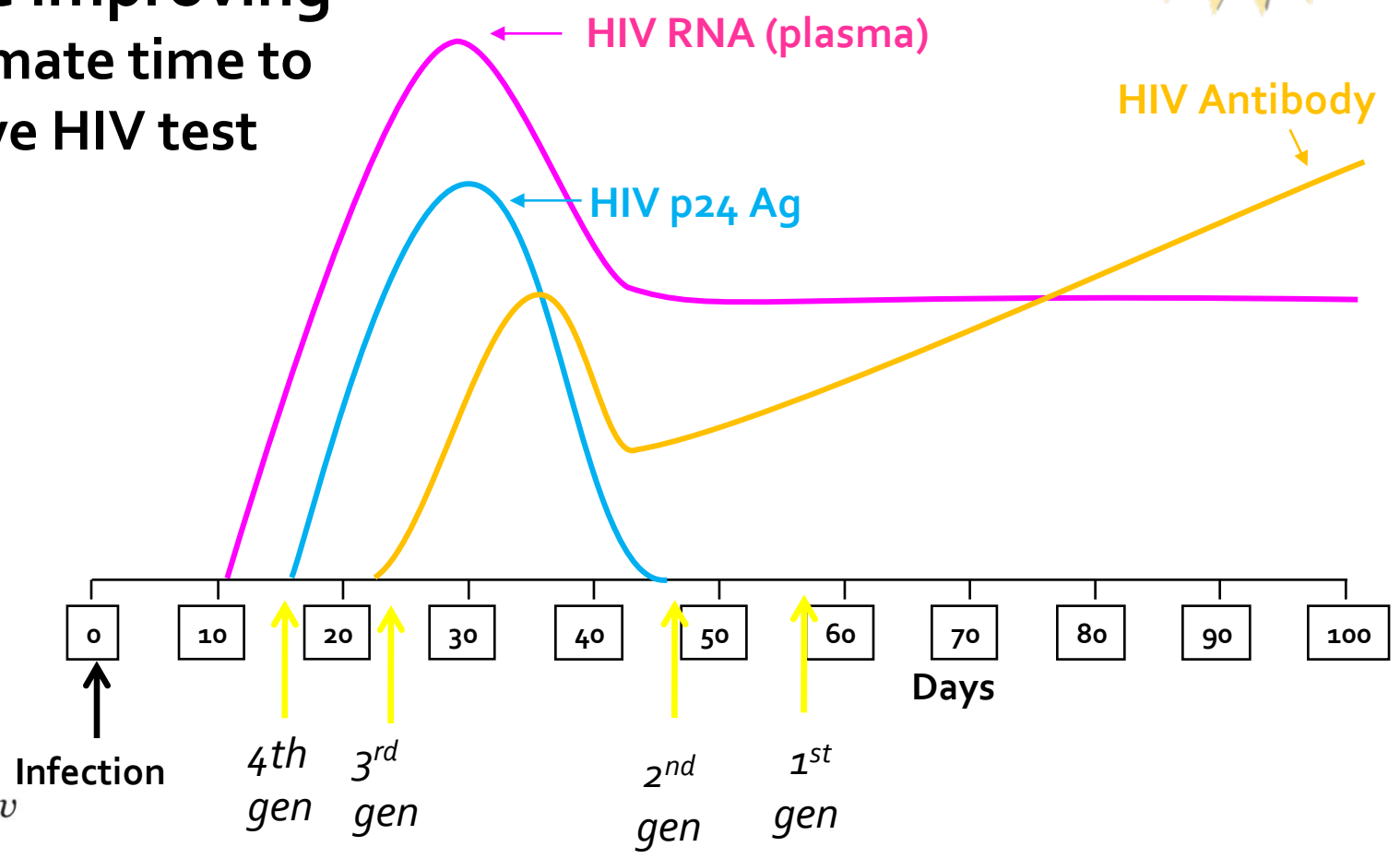
Year of HIV Dx	Number of Dx	AIDS within 1 year
1996	18,016	43%
2001	38,818	36%
2006	38,496	36%
2009	45,336	32%

- In 2009, only 40% of all adults had ever been tested for HIV
- In addition, for people at high risk, testing not frequent enough

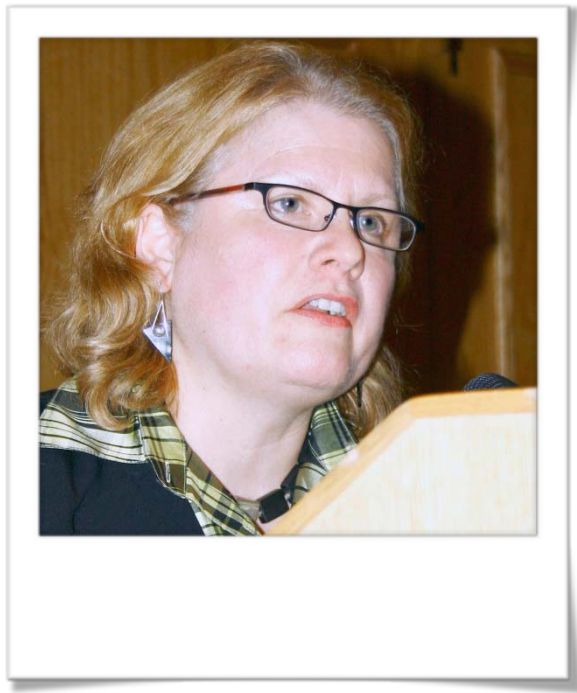


Sensitivity of HIV tests are improving

The U. S. Global AIDS Coordinator's mission is to lead implementation of the U.S. President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR). PEPFAR is the U.S. Government initiative to help save the lives of those suffering from HIV/ AIDS around the world.





Importance of International HIV Counseling & Testing (HTC) Programs

- An estimated 33 million people worldwide are living with HIV/AIDS, an estimated less than 20 percent know they are HIV-positive.
- HIV Counseling and Testing is a Critical Gateway to Treatment, Care and Support, and Prevention
 - Expansion of services to help individuals, couples and families learn their HIV status is cornerstone to provision of HIV prevention, treatment and care services.



Overarching Goals Of PEPFAR HIV Testing & Counseling (HTC) Programs

- Provide services for individuals, couples/partners, and families to learn their HIV status
- Implement strategies for ensuring individuals, couples, and families are linked with appropriate follow up HIV treatment, care and support, and prevention services based on their sero-status



The Approaches To HTC

Person

- **Provider-initiated** HIV Testing and Counseling
 - occurring through a health care provider as a standard component of medical care
- **Client-initiated** HIV Testing and Counseling
 - occurring through active seeking of HIV Testing and Counseling by a client(s) in settings where these services are available.

The Approaches to HIV Testing and Counseling Place



Clinical settings that include:

- Antenatal clinic (ANC) settings,
- Outpatient Departments, TB clinics, STI services, VMMC settings, medical and surgical wards in hospitals, HIV care and treatment clinics, etc.
(Provider-initiated)

Non-clinical or community-based settings that include:

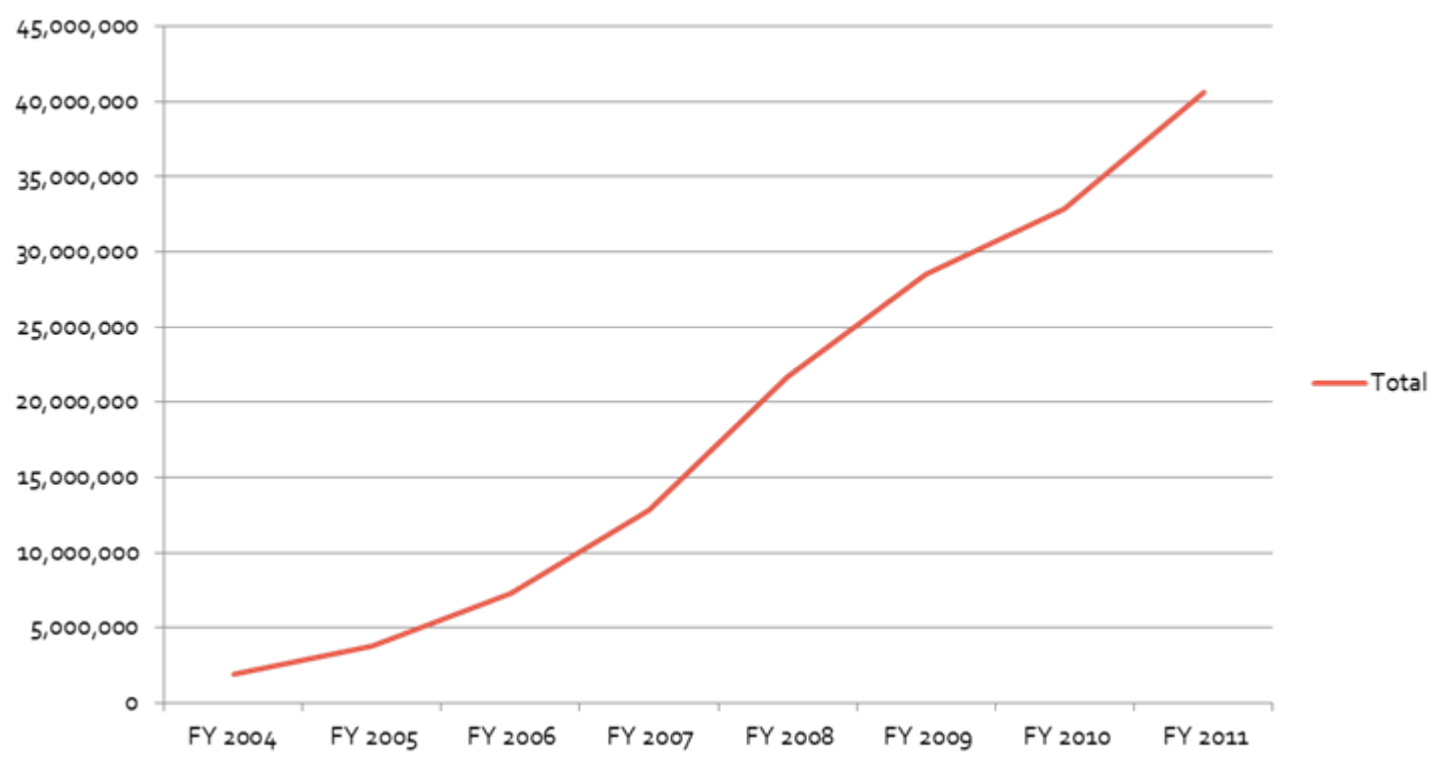
- Home-based HTC via index patient or door-to-door HTC
- Mobile or outreach HTC targeting specific communities or populations
- Stand-alone Voluntary Counseling and Testing or VCT (Client-initiated)

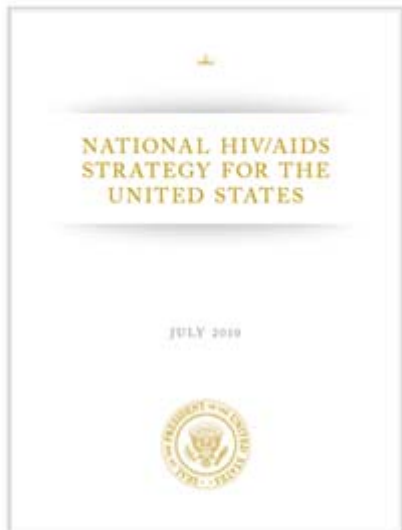

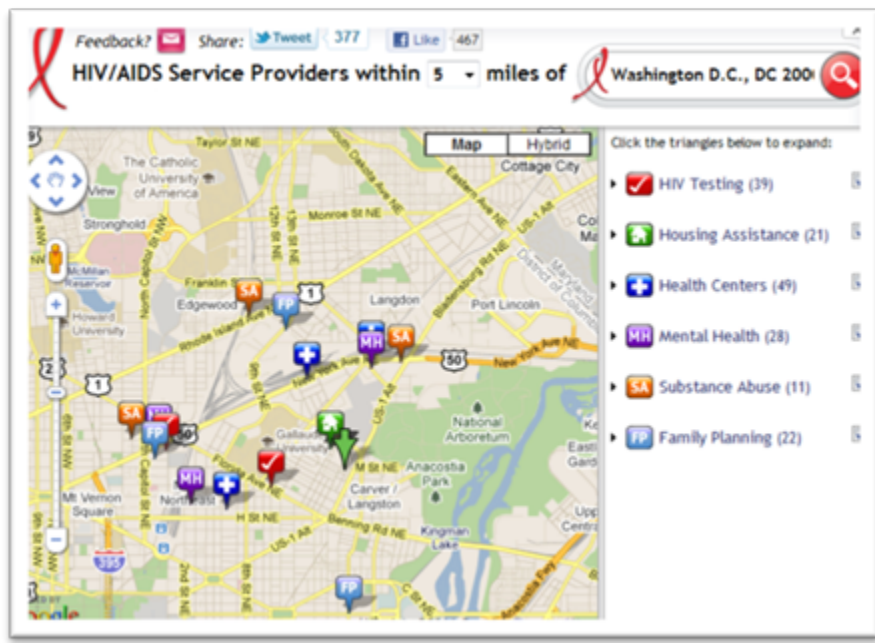

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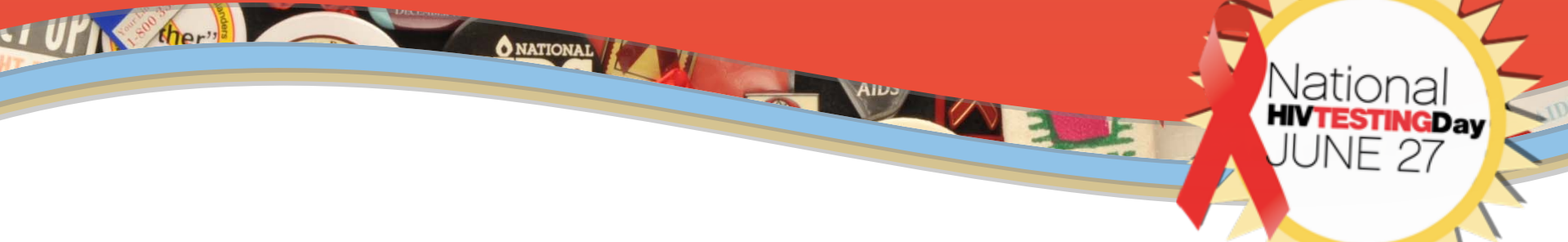
