  - Reduce errors






# Front Door of Online Applications

- Use clear, simple & welcoming language
- Describe benefits accessible
- Reassure consumers' privacy



## Front Door: Screeners

- Optional
- Direct consumers to apply now on each page
- Cast the net wide, but not too wide
- Clarify that it is not a final determination

## Additional Programs

It also looks like you may be eligible for some additional programs. All you need to do is answer a few more questions.

### FoodShare

This is Wisconsin's version of the federal Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). FoodShare benefits come on a plastic card, called the Wisconsin QUEST Card, which you can use to buy food at most food stores.

### Child Care

This program provides help with paying for child care for children under 13 years old.

### Wisconsin Works

This program gives cash assistance to needy families with dependent children, and to pregnant women, to help them meet the basic needs of their children.

# Front Door: Accounts Setup & Functions


- Avoid requiring complicated passwords
- Don't require email address
- Use check marks to prompt consumers





# Keep it Simple: Limit Questions


- Don't ask anything that is unnecessary
- Use dynamic questioning
- Allow nonapplicants
- Allow applicants to skip questions





# Keep it Simple: Help and Navigation

- Use pop ups or tool tips
- Make help, helpful
- Use tabs and allow consumer to toggle
- Let consumers know how far they are in the application






# Keep it Simple: Documentation Options

- Use administrative verification options
- Allow for scanning, emailing, faxing documents



# **How to Apply**

### Online

You can apply online! The application will take you about 20 minutes and can be completed and submitted online. On the last page of the online application, all you need to do is: 1) enter your name correctly, 2) accept the Rights and Responsibilities and 3) click on the submit button. Your application will then be electronically signed and sent directly to FAMIS. You also have the option to scan and upload any needed documents using the member services section of this website or if you prefer, you can mail or fax them in. To begin an application online click on the "Apply Online' button.

FAMIS enrollees must renew their coverage every year. When it is time you can also renew your children's coverage online. Once you receive your renewal letter, just visit the Renewing Coverage page or click **here**.
