Advance Report on Durable Goods Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories and Orders February 2011

New Orders. New orders for manufactured durable goods in February decreased \$1.9 billion or 0.9 percent to \$200.0 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau announced today. This decrease, down four of the last five months, followed a 3.6 percent January increase. Excluding transportation, new orders decreased 0.6 percent. Excluding defense, new orders increased 0.4 percent. Machinery, down two consecutive months, had the largest decrease, \$1.2 billion or 4.2 percent to \$26.6 billion.

Shipments. Shipments of manufactured durable goods in February, up five of the last six months, increased \$0.7 billion or 0.3 percent to \$203.2 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent January increase. Machinery, up three of the last four months, had the largest increase, \$0.7 billion or 2.6 percent to \$26.1 billion.

Unfilled Orders. Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in February, up ten of the last eleven months, increased \$2.9 billion or 0.4 percent to \$833.7 billion. This followed a 0.7 percent January increase. Transportation equipment, up two consecutive months, had the largest increase, \$1.1 billion or 0.2 percent to \$477.3 billion.

Inventories. Inventories of manufactured durable goods in February, up fourteen consecutive months, increased \$2.9 billion or 0.9 percent to \$328.3 billion. This followed a 0.9 percent January increase. Transportation equipment, also up fourteen consecutive months, had the largest increase, \$0.8 billion or 0.9 percent to \$87.8 billion.

Capital Goods. Nondefense new orders for capital goods in February increased \$1.7 billion or 2.5 percent to \$69.1 billion. Shipments increased \$0.7 billion or 1.1 percent to \$66.2 billion. Unfilled orders increased \$2.9 billion or 0.6 percent to \$505.1 billion. Inventories increased \$1.2 billion or 0.8 percent to \$139.7 billion. Defense new orders for capital goods in February decreased \$2.8 billion or 24.8 percent to \$8.3 billion. Shipments increased \$0.2 billion or 2.5 percent to \$8.5 billion. Unfilled orders decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.1 percent to \$141.4 billion. Inventories increased \$0.1 billion or 0.4 percent to \$17.6 billion.

Revised January Data. Revised seasonally adjusted January figures for all manufacturing industries were: new orders, \$446.1 billion (revised from \$445.6 billion); shipments, \$446.7 billion (revised from \$447.4 billion); unfilled orders, \$830.8 billion (revised from \$829.6 billion); and total inventories, \$560.2 billion (revised from \$559.3 billion).

¹ Estimates of shipments and new orders are for the duration of the period, while estimates of unfilled orders and total inventories are for the end of the period. Not seasonally adjusted estimates of shipments and new orders include adjusted data for non-calendar reporters. Seasonally adjusted estimates include concurrent adjustments for holiday and trading-day differences, where appropriate, as well as seasonal variation, based on the results of the latest annual review of the model parameters. Estimates are not adjusted for price changes.

² Based on advance sample. Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories, and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. ³ The Capital Goods Industries include Nondefense: small arms and ordnance; farm machinery; and equipment; construction machinery; mining, oil, and gas field machinery; industrial machinery; vending, laundry, and other machinery; photographic equipment; material handling equipment; all other machinery; electroic computers; computer storage devices; other computer peripheral equipment; communications equipment; peripheral equipment; all other machinery; electroic computers; computer storage devices; other computer peripheral equipment; and control instruments; electrical equipment; other electrical equipment, appliances, and components; heavy duty trucks; aircraft; railroad rolling stock; ships and boats; office and institutional furniture; and medical equipment and supplies.

Defense Capital Goods include: small arms and ordnance, communications equipment, aircraft; missiles, space vehicles, and parts, ships and boats, and search and navigation equipment.

⁴ Estimates of shipments for the semiconductor industry are no longer shown separately. Estimates and percent changes of shipments and inventories for the semiconductor industry are included in computers and electronic products, and all other applicable aggregate totals. Estimates and percent changes for new orders and unfilled orders exclude semiconductor industry data.
