REPORT OF THE AUDIT-DIVISION ON THE THORPE FOR CONGRESS COMMITTEE

I. Background

A. Overview

This report is based on an audit of the Thorpe for Congress Committee ("the Committee"), undertaken by the Audit Division of the Federal Election Commission in accordance with the Co mission's audit policy to determine whether there has been c mpliance with the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The audit was conducted pursuant to Section 430(a)(8) of Title 2 of the United States Code which directs the Commission to make from time to time audits and field investigations with respect to reports and statements filed under the provisions of the Act.

The Committee registered with the Federal Election Commission on January 27, 1976, in support of Henry B. Thorpe, Jr., a candidate for election to the office of Representative of the Second Congressional District of North Carolina. On March 20, 1976, the Committee was designated by the Cansidate as his principal carpaign committee for the 1976 election. The Committee maintained its headquarters in Rocky Mount, North Carolina.

The audit covered the period from Canuary 1, 1976, through December 31, 1977, the termination date of the Committee. During this period the Committee and the Candidate reported the following activity:
