#### I. Background

#### A. Overview

This report is based upon an audit of the campaign of Mr. Roger Lea MacBride, the MacBride for President Committee, and 14 authorized state committees. The audit was undertaken by the Audit Division of the Federal Election Commission in accordance with the Commission's audit policy to determine whether there has been compliance with the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The audit was conducted pursuant to Section 438(a)(8) of Title 2 of the United States Code, which at the time of the audit directed the Commission to make, from time to time, audits and field investigations with respect to reports and statements filed under the provisions of the Act.

Roger Lea MacBride, the National Libertarian Party's candidate for President in 1976, filed a Statement of a Candidate with the Federal Election Commission on October 8, 1975, designating the MacBride for President Committee ("the Committee") as his principal campaign committee. The Committee filed a Statement of Organization with the Commission on October 22, 1975. The Committee maintained its headquarters in Washington, D.C.

The audit covered the period July 1, 1975 through March 31, 1977. During that period the Candidate reported expenditures from personal funds of \$266,276.48, which included \$155,000.00 in loans to the principal campaign committee. The Committee and authorized state committees reported a combined beginning cash total of \$0.00, total receipts (net of inter-committee transfers) of \$429,791.31, total expenditures (net of inter-committee transfers) of \$430,138.50, and total ending cash of \$239.60. 1/

The discrepancy between receipts, expenditures and closing cash is a result of the various committees' failure to file continuous reports.

This audit report is based on documents and working papers supporting each of its factual statements. They formpart of the record upon which the Commission based its decisions on the matters in this report and were available to Commissioners and appropriate staff for review.

### B. Few Personnel

The principal officers of the principal campaign committee and all authorized state committees during the period of the audit are listed on Attachment I.

### C. Scope

The audit included such tents as verification of total reported receipts and expenditures and individual transactions; review of required supporting documentation; analysis of Committed debts and obligations; and, such other audit procedures as deemed necessary under the circumstances.

## II. Audit Findings and Personmendations
