REPORT OF THE AUDIT DIVISION
ON THE
ANTHONY A. MCCORD CAMPAIGN

I. Background

A. Overview

This report is based on a review of the Anthony A. McCord Campaign undertaken by the Audit Division of the Federal Election Commission in accordance with the Commission's audit policy to determine whether there has been compliance with the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The review was conducted pursuant to Section 438(a) (8) of Title 2, United States Code, which directs the Commission to make from time to time audits and field investigations with respect to reports and statements filed under the provisions of the Act.

The Candidate filed an FEC Form 2 (Statement of a Candidate for Nomination or Election to Federal Office) with the Commission on July 19, 1976 thereby establishing his candidacy for the office of United States Representative from the Sixth (6th) Congressional District of Kentucky. Mr. McCord designated himself as his principal campaign committee and noted he would spend no money in his campaign. In the general election, Mr. McCord received 6.0% of the vote, thereby meeting the criteria established by the Commission's Audit Policy of November 11, 1976 with respect to candidates involved in congressional elections.

The review covered the period January 1, 1976 through November 19, 1976, the date on which Mr. McCord filed a termination report. Reports filed during the period covered by the review show an opening cash balance, total receipts, total expenditures and a closing cash balance of \$-0-.

This report is based on documents and working papers which support each of the factual statements. They form part of the record upon which the Commission based its decisions on the matters in this report and were available to Commissioners and appropriate staff for review.



B. Scope

The review included examination of statements filed and discussions with the parties involved and such other audit procedures deemed necessary under the circumstances.

Auditor's Statement

It is the opinion of the Audit staff, based upon examination of the reports and statements filed and discussions with the candidate and an official of the American Party, that the reports and statements of Anthony A. McCord fairly present the financial activities of his campaign for the period covered by the review. No material problems in complying with the Federal Election Campaign Act were discovered during the course of the review.
