**Purpose of Modification:**

The purpose of this modification is to do the following:

1. Definitize the contract Change Order issued in modification M002 to implement the Office of Environmental Management (EM) Quality Assurance Program :
  - a. In Section J-2, Table J.2.8, *Directives, Regulations, Policies and Standards*, add the Quality Assurance Program (QAP) (EM-QA-001, Revision 0).
  - b. The addition of this new requirement increased the contract value by \$152,722 (\$37,154 in FY 2009 and \$104,913 in FY 2010 for a total cost of \$142,067 in CLIN 1 and \$10,655 in Fee).
2. Definitize the contract Change Order issued in modification M010 to implement DOE N234.1, Reporting of Radioactive Sealed Sources and DOE M 441.1, Nuclear Material Packaging:
  - a. In Section J-2, Table J.2.8, *Directives, Regulations, Policies and Standards*, add DOE N234.1, Reporting of Radioactive Sealed Sources.
  - b. The addition of this new requirement increased the contract value by \$106,634 in FY 2010 – FY2018. (\$47,083 in FY 2009, \$5,238 in FY 2010, \$5,385 in FY 2011, \$5,514 in FY 2012, \$5,646 in FY 2013, \$5,782 in FY 2014, \$5,920 in FY 2015, \$6,062 in FY 2016, \$6,208 in FY 2017 and \$6,357 in FY 2018 for a total of \$99,195 in CLIN 1 and \$7,439 in Fee )
  - c. In Section J-2, Table J.2.8, *Directives, Regulations, Policies and Standards*, add DOE M 441.1, Nuclear Material Packaging. The addition of this order shall have no cost or schedule impacts to the contract.
3. Update Section B, B.4-1 Table to incorporate the definitized contract Change Order issued in contract modification 038 that implemented DOE Order 450.1a; ANSI/ISA 84; DOE Std 3009 CN3a and FAR 52.245-1.
  - a. The addition of these requirements increased the contract value by \$3,578,880 in FY2010 – FY2018. ( (1) DOE 450.1a: \$262,500 in FY 2009, \$103,949 in FY 2010, \$106,860 in FY2011, \$148,714 in FY 2012, \$112,050 in FY 2013, \$114,740 in FY 2014, \$159,680 in FY 2015, \$120,313 in FY 2016, \$123,201 in FY 2017 and \$171,455 in FY 2018 for a total increase of \$1,423,462; (2) ANSI/ISA: \$48,500 in FY 2009, \$8,936 in FY 2010, \$9,151 in FY 2011, \$9,371 in FY 2012, \$9,595 in FY 2013, \$9,826 in FY 2014, \$10,062 in FY 2015, \$10,303 in FY 2016, \$10,550 in FY 2017 and \$10,804 in FY 2018

for a total increase of \$137,098; and (3) STD-3009 CN3a: \$1,071,500 in FY 2009 and \$697,132 in FY 2010, for a total increase of \$1,768,632).

- b. Total increase of these requirements was \$3,329,191 in cost and \$249,689 in Fee.
- c. Incorporation of FAR clause 52.245-1 in contract modification 38 was at no cost or schedule impact.

- (a) If this Contract expires or terminates and the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has awarded a contract under which the new contractor becomes a sponsor of the Hanford Site Pension Plan (HSPP), Hanford Site Savings Plan (HSSP), Hanford Employee Welfare Trust (HEWT), Market-Based Plans and Legacy Plans as defined in paragraph (a) of the Section H Clause entitled, *Employee Compensation: Pay and Benefits*, of this Contract, and becomes responsible for management, and administration of the Market-Based Plans and Legacy Plans, the Contractor shall cooperate and transfer to the new contractor its responsibility for sponsorship, management and administration of the plans as appropriate and consistent with direction from the Contracting Officer.
- (b) If this Contract expires or terminates without a contract with a new contractor under which the new contractor becomes a sponsor of the HSPP, HSSP, HEWT, Market-Based Plans and Legacy Plans as defined in paragraph (a) of the Section H Clause entitled, *Employee Compensation: Pay and Benefits*, of this Contract, and becomes responsible for management and administration of the Market-Based Plans and Legacy Plans, or if the Contracting Officer determines that the scope of work under the Contract has been completed (any one such event may be deemed by the Contracting Officer to be "Contract Completion" for purposes of this clause), whichever is earlier, and notwithstanding any other obligations and requirements concerning expiration or termination under any other clause of this Contract, the following actions shall occur regarding the Contractor's obligations regarding all of the plans as defined in
