# Support the Flores Amendment to Prevent New Layers of Federal Bureaucracy

May 8, 2012

Dear Colleague,

This week the House will vote on <u>H.R. 5326</u>, making appropriations for the Departments of Commerce and Justice, Science, and Related Agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, and for other purposes.

As part of House Republicans effort to combat unnecessary spending and burdensome federal regulations, Representative Flores (TX-17) is sponsoring an amendment to prohibit funding for the implementation of President Obama's National Ocean Policy.

Created by Executive Order, the initiative calls for mandatory ocean zoning, a policy that effectively allows the federal government to determine where certain activities can take place in our oceans and along our shores. If implemented, the National Ocean Policy will add layer upon layer of new, federal bureaucracy, creating uncertainty for businesses and job creators and opening up the floodgates for frivolous lawsuits.

The new Federally-controlled system of regional planning bodies will have broad authority to issue regulations potentially impacting all activities that occur on lands adjacent to rivers, tributaries or watersheds that eventually drain into the ocean. Therefore, the heavy hand of the National Ocean Policy could reach far inland, inflicting damage across a spectrum of sectors including agriculture, fishing, construction, manufacturing, mining, oil and natural gas, and renewable energy, among others. These industries support tens of millions of jobs and contribute trillions of dollars to the U.S. economy.

Just last month over <u>80 groups</u> representing these sectors including the U.S. Chamber of Commerce, American Farm Bureau Federation, National Association of Homebuilders, American Forest & Paper Association, National Fisheries Institute and Recreational Fishing Alliance sent a letter to appropriators asking for an amendment to prohibit funding for the National Ocean Policy. The Flores amendment will accomplish this goal and allow Congress to hit the pause button on funding until the true job and economic impacts of this policy are known. I strongly encourage you to support the Flores Amendment to H.R. 5326.
