A single system that allows Education Directorate personnel to enter the particulars associated with each of their budget line items, calculate estimated costs, and produce associated reports, including those related to Professional Development (PD) days and funding transfers, and tracks actual expenditures for a particular fiscal year. The system also accommodates the preparation and tracking of the Directorate's Advanced Acquisition Plan.

Categories of records in the system:

Records consist of : first name, last name, DoDEA e-mail address, fax number, name of area/district/school, and contact phone number of the Coordinator in charge of specific budget plans for a specified fiscal year for the ED Directorate Branch.

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

Risk of unauthorized access to and use of the PII collected information.

To address the risk of unauthorized access to and use of the PII collected information, access to the system is password protected and is authenticated thru DoDEA name and password enabled access to the web server.

Privacy Act notification is prompted upon successful login to the system and is likewise evident in the system's various forms and reports (thru headers and/or footers).

Furnishing the requested personal data is voluntary. If they do not furnish the requested PII they cannot obtain a user account and use the ED Directorate Budget System.

All PII collected is required to complete a user account and gain access to the system to create/submit budget plans and track actual expenditures. The PII collected and combinations of such is used for: (a) System access authentication; (b) Record identification for budget planning, approval and expenditure tracking purposes.
