BioPreferred and EcoLogo™ Partner to Establish Hand-Sanitizer Standard



EcoLogo, a third-party, multi-attribute eco-labeling program, released its first environmental standard for hand sanitizers, adopting BioPreferred's biobased minimum content standards. The EcoLogo certification will help consumers identify

environmentally friendly instant hand antiseptic products.

Ohio Biobased Product Procurement Program - Bill Passed

Governor Ted Strickland signed <u>S.B. 131</u> on February 27, establishing a preferred purchasing program for biobased products in Ohio. With the legislation, Ohio becomes the first state in the country with such a program requiring Ohio's state agencies and state-supported colleges and universities to purchase biobased products when available. Modeled after the USDA BioPreferred program, a certification process will identify approved biobased products. The bill is anticipated to take effect May 2010.

Biobased Multi-Purpose Cleaner

Biobased multi-purpose cleaners are as effective as traditional cleaners but are made

from renewable resources like corn, sugarcane, citrus and coconut, rather than petroleum or alcohol. In addition to being more environmentally responsible, some biobased multi-purpose cleaners are even non-toxic, reducing expenses of precautionary labeling, storage, flammability, spill clean-up and shipping.
