### Race Concepts

 Race alone population – people who reported a single race group

(e.g., White alone; Black alone)

- Race in combination population people who reported more than one race group (e.g., White and Black; Black and Asian)
- Race alone or in combination population —
   all people who reported a particular race group,
   either alone, or in combination with one or more
   other race groups

# Definition of "White" Used in the 2010 Census

- According to the U.S. Office of Management and Budget, "White" refers to a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.
- The "White" racial category includes respondents who marked the "White" checkbox. It also includes respondents who reported entries such as
  - Caucasian or White
  - European (e.g., Irish, German, Polish)
  - Middle Eastern (e.g., Arab, Lebanese, Palestinian)
  - North African (e.g., Algerian, Moroccan, Egyptian)





# White Population as a Percentage of the Total Population: 2000 and 2010





# White Population as a Percentage of the Total Population: 2000 and 2010






# Growth of the White Population: 2000 to 2010


# Percentage Distribution of the Multiple-Race White Population: 2010





### Percentage Distribution of the Growth of the White Population by Hispanic Origin: 2000 to 2010





# Percentage Distribution of the White Population by Region: 2010





## Percentage Distribution of the White Population by Hispanic Origin and State: 2010





### Non-Hispanic White Alone or in Combination as a Percent of Total Population by County: 2010






### Hispanic White Alone or in Combination as a Percent of Total Population by County: 2010




# Percentage Change in Non-Hispanic White Alone or in Combination by County: 2000 to 2010


### Percentage Change in Hispanic White Alone or in Combination by County: 2000 to 2010

# Definition of "Black" Used in the 2010 Census


- According to the U.S. Office of Management and Budget, "Black or African American" refers to a person having origins in any of the Black racial groups of Africa.
- Includes people who marked the "Black" checkbox
- It also includes respondents who reported entries such as
  - African American
  - Sub-Saharan African (e.g., Kenyan and Nigerian)
  - Afro-Caribbean (e.g., Haitian and Jamaican)


# Black Population as a Percentage of the Total Population: 2000 and 2010




### Growth of the Black Population: 2000 to 2010



# Percent Distribution of the Black Population by Region: 2010






# Top Five States with the Highest Proportion Black Alone or in Combination: 2010


# Percentage Distribution of the Black Population by State: 2010




#### Black Alone or in Combination as a Percent of **Total Population by County: 2010**








# Black in Combination Population Distribution by County: 2010




## Top Five Places with the Highest Proportion Black Alone or in Combination: 2010\*
