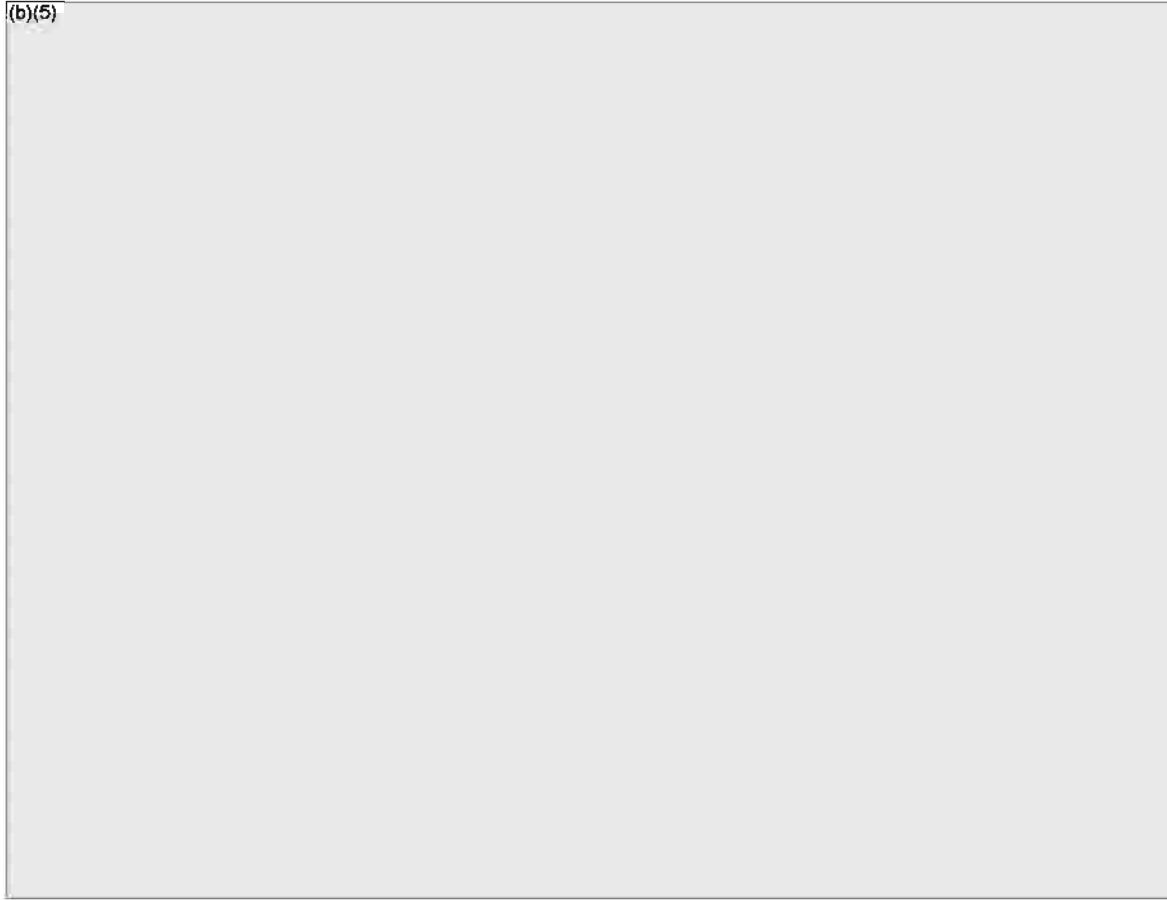
Talking Points – Question 4: DoD plan for addressing detention risk/security issues in Afghanistan and in Iraq when current detention operations transition to host nations?

- GWOT detainees in AFG and IZ are detained per United Nations Security Council Resolutions (UNSCR), Law of War provisions, or arrangements with host-nations

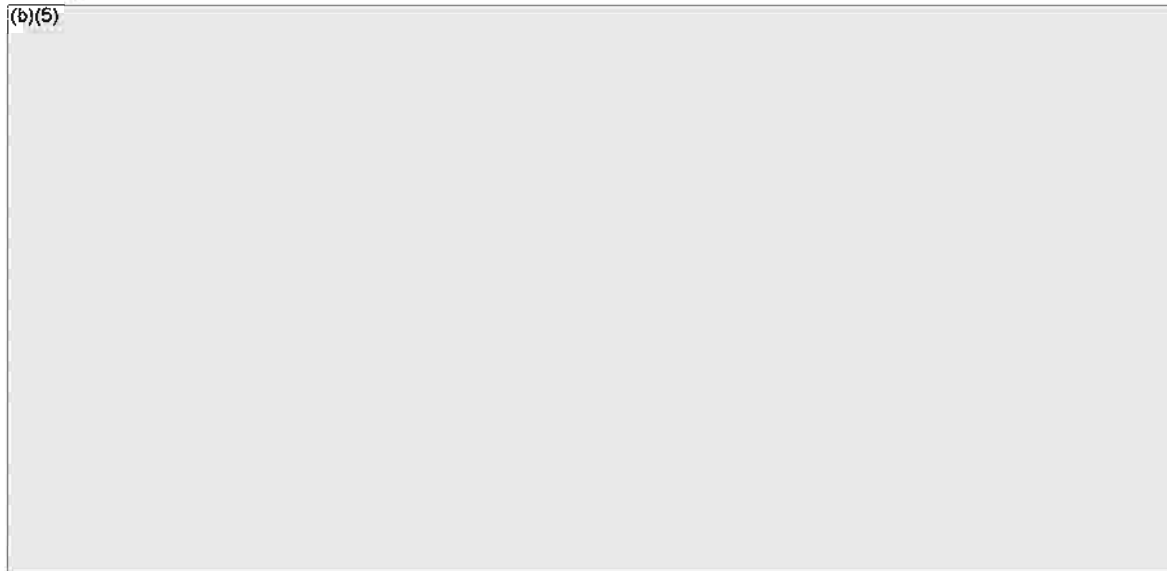
