Lieutenant Colonel William Glaser is the centrally selected Director of TRADOC Project Office – One Semi-Automated Forces (OneSAF). He is a native of Hendersonville, Tennessee and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in Armor from the United States Military Academy at West Point in 1993. Following graduation from the Armor Officer Basic Course, Lieutenant Colonel Glaser was assigned to the 3rd Infantry Division in Vilseck, Germany, where he served as Tank Platoon Leader in 2-37 AR and deployed to Macedonia in support of Operation Able Sentry as a Company Executive Officer.

After completing the Armor Officer Advanced Course, Lieutenant Colonel Glaser served as an instructor at the Armor Officer Basic Course and was subsequently assigned to the 3rd Infantry Division at Fort Stewart, Georgia, where he served as an Assistant S3, Battalion Maintenance Officer, and Tank Company Commander in 4-64 AR. He was then selected to command the 2nd Brigade Headquarters and Headquarters Company during Operation Desert Spring in Kuwait in 2002 followed by Operation Iraqi Freedom in 2003. Upon redeploying, he served on the CAC-Training Headquarters Staff and then as a Maneuver Observer Trainer for Operations Group Charlie, Battle Command Training Program at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. In 2005, he attended the Simulation Operations Course and the Army Command and General Staff College.

In 2006, he returned to the 3rd Infantry Division to serve as the Chief of Simulations and then as the Division Battle Command Officer while deployed to Operations Iraqi Freedom V. From 2008-2010, he attended the Naval Postgraduate School where he received a Master's of Science in Modeling, Virtual Environments, and Simulations. Upon graduation, he was assigned to Office of Military Cooperation – Kuwait, where he served as the primary advisor to the Kuwait Armed Forces J3. He was then centrally selected to serve as the Director of TRADOC Project Office – One Semi-Automated Forces at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.

Lieutenant Colonel Glaser's military awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Army Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, and Army Achievement Medal. He is also authorized the wear of the Combat Action Badge, Parachutist Badge, Army Meritorious Unit Commendation, and the Presidential Unit Citation.
