SUBJECT: Request for Verification of Date Last Worked for Railroad Employer

Please review the attached listing of employees who have recently stopped railroad employment and applied for Railroad Retirement Act (RRA) age and service or disability annuities. The dates on the listing are based on the information the employees provided on their annuity applications. The actual *Date Last Worked* for your railroad and, if later, the last day of any *Pay for Time Lost* are important because these dates affect the date the employee RRA annuities can begin. Please verify that these dates are correct.

Also, for age and service applicants and a few disability applicants, please verify the date the employees provided as the "*Date Relinquished Rights*" to return to work for your company.

If any of the dates provided by the employees are not correct, please cross out the incorrect date and write the correct date above it. Return the corrected listing to the Retirement Benefits Division-RIS. The fax number is (312) 751-7192.

If all of the dates on the listing are correct, it is not necessary to return the listing to us.
